Key Features

Interviews - use of speech and dialogue for the people involved to discuss their thoughts

Relative clauses - adding further information to our sentences (Harry Potter, who is the youngest seeker in over 50 years, flew close to the ground as he approached the Golden Snitch)

Formal language - match reports are published in newspapers, magazines and websites, meaning they have to include formal language

Impartial and balanced factual content - match reports are not meant to be biased, meaning you cannot write favourably about your favourite team or write negatively about your least favourite
