Dear parents and carers,

#### **Breck Foundation**

Y3/4/5/6 worked with the Breck Foundation on Thursday, to better understand how to stay safe online. It was a very interesting and shocking presentation, which highlighted again for us here at school how children can so easily become victims online.

I have included in this week's newsletter email some resources from the Breck Foundation to help parents 'Have the Chat' with your children about staying safe online.

### **School Uniform Standards**

We have noticed that some of our children are looking a little scruffy at the moment. Please can I remind you that our school uniform is a red T-shirt, grey trousers/skirt/dress, grey logoed jumper/cardigan, grey/black/red tight, black shoes. PE uniform is a white T shirt, black tracksuit bottoms/leggings/shorts and a SCHOOL jumper or cardigan. Hats can be worn outside only. No necklaces, rings, bracelets or smart watches (which can record or film – this is a safeguarding issue), earrings should be study only.

# Please Park considerately

We know that getting children to school on time can sometimes be stressful, but we have been approached by a number of local residents who are concerned by the parking before and after school.

Please can I request that parents park with due care and consideration for our neighbours. Also, can I remind you that the zigzag area at the front of school is <u>not</u> to be parked on.

### Holidays in Term Time

Our policy in school is to NOT agree holidays in term time unless there are very exceptional circumstances. It is also our policy to refer the non-attendance to Cornwall Council.

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If your child is absent from school without authorisation, you will be committing an offence under the Education Act 1996. We may submit a request to Cornwall Council for a Penalty Notice to be issued, in accordance with Sections 444A and 444B of the said Act. Penalty Notices are issued per liable parent, per child and each carry a fine of £60 if paid within 21 days or £120 if paid after this but within 28 days. Failure to pay the Penalty Notice may result in legal action. Absence not authorised by the school may result in a prosecution in the Magistrates' Court under Section 444(1) or Section 444(1A) of the Education Act 1996, leading to a fine of up to £2,500 and/or a custodial sentence.
