Prayer—To speak to God, often to praise god, say sorry, you or ask for something.

Creation—To make something that didn't exist before.

The son of God sent to teach people about God and how to live good lives. The religion is named after him


#### Christianity

## <u>The Bible</u>

The Christian holy book is a collection of books to teach Christians about God, Jesus and how to live good lives. It is organised into two main parts. The Old Testament is about what happened before Jesus was born and the New Testament is all about Jesus' life and his teachings.
