Bethlehem—The place of Jesus' birth.


Celebrate—Take part in some activities for a particular occasion

Why: The star that led the Three Wise Men to the stable in Bethlehem.

<u>Light</u>

How: Candles, hanging lights and tree lights

Why: The light of God coming to the world.

<u>Gifts</u>

How: Presents are given to friends and family.

Why: Gifts given to Jesus by Wise Men. Gold, Frankincense, Myrrh.
