**RE**—Religious Education. Learning about different religions and beliefs.

**Religion**—Belief and worship of a god or gods.

**Christianity**—Based on teachings of Jesus Christ, the son of God.

**Belief**—Thinking something is true or real.

**Faith**—Strong belief or trust in someone or something.

**God**—Christians believe in only one god who created the world.

**Jesus**—Founder of Christianity, believed to be son of God.

**Bible**—Christian Holy book with texts and teachings for Christians

**Gospels**—Part of Bible that teaches Christians about Jesus' life

**Non-religious**—People who do not believe in religion or a God.

**Unique**—Being the only one of its kind, unlike anything else.

**Valuable**—Someone or something important or worth a lot.

**Charity**—Help others without getting something back. Name given to groups who provide free help to those in need.

**Fundraising**—Organise event to raise money for a good cause.

**Born:** 1910 (Macedonia)

**Died:** 1997 (Calcutta)

**Who:** Humanitarian - she did things to help other people.  
Nun - dedicated her life to God and to helping others.

**What:** Spent many years of her life in very poor part of India, helping poor, homeless or sick people.

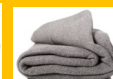
