Key Beliefs

Islam

Muslims follow the religion of Islam. The word 'Islam' means submission and obedience to Allah.

God

Muslim's believe there is only one God who is ruler of the universe. They call him Allah, which means 'God' in Arabic.

Allah's prophets

Sent by Allah to teach people about him. The most important prophet was Muhammad. He is so special, they say "peace be upon him" after speaking his name. Allah sent the words of the Qur'an to him to share with all Muslims. He was born in Mecca, Saudi Arabia.

Qur'an

The Muslim holy book. Muslims believe it is a record of Allah's exact words, written down by Muhammad.

It has been written in Arabic only for over 1400 years.

Mosque

Where Muslims worship. Services are held daily but the most important one is on Fridays. Mosques often have a domed roof. Muslims take off their shoes before they enter a mosque and wash before they pray.
