Dear Parents,

It was great for us to be able to catch up with parents last week during Parents' Evening. Thank you for the positive feedback which we received, it is always good to know that the children are happy in school. If you were not able to make an appointment last week, please do let your class teacher know and they will be able to find a mutually convenient time to speak.

School Improvement Visit:

Last week we received the report from our school improvement officer who spent the day with us during the last week of half term. I am delighted to let you know that his findings were very positive, citing the children's enthusiasm for learning and their love of their school. It is always reassuring to work with external advisors and in this case, we also welcomed the headteachers from Flushing and Mawnan who came to complete lesson observations, pupil conferencing and book looks.



What to do if I or my child have COVID19 symptoms.

- 1. Book a PCR test for the symptomatic person and then follow this flow chart.
- 2. If the test is positive, all members of the household are strongly advised to also take a PCR test, regardless of whether they are symptomatic.

Please note children DO NOT need to self-isolate unless THEY have a positive COVID19 test result.eg a parent/sibling may test positive, but unless the child receives a positive test, they must still attend school.
