Parking

We have been messaged by our local bus services that they are finding driving through the village in the afternoons increasingly difficult due to poorly or double-parked cars, particularly on Bells Hill, often causing frustrating delays of 20mins or more. Please can we remind you that if a bus cannot get through, a fire engine or ambulance certainly cannot and they will not mind "moving" your car out of the way to get to an emergency.

It has also been noticed that unfortunately parents have been parking on the zig-zag yellow lines by the school. Parking on these lines, regardless of whether you stay in the vehicle, is not only illegal but more importantly incredibly dangerous for our children when crossing the road. Park further from the school, use the Lemon Arms carpark, or further along Comfort Road where there is less traffic and plenty of spaces. Thank you.

What to do if I or my child have COVID19 symptoms.

1. Book a PCR test for the symptomatic person and then follow this flow chart.
2. If the test is positive, all members of the household are strongly advised to also take a PCR test, regardless of whether they are symptomatic.

Please note children DO NOT need to self-isolate unless THEY have a positive COVID19 test result. eg a parent/sibling may test positive, but unless the child receives a positive test, they must still attend school.
