Never living—Things that have never been living. They never had the life processes.

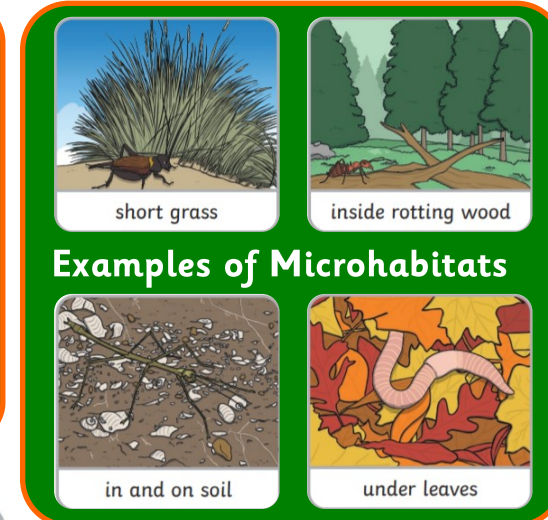
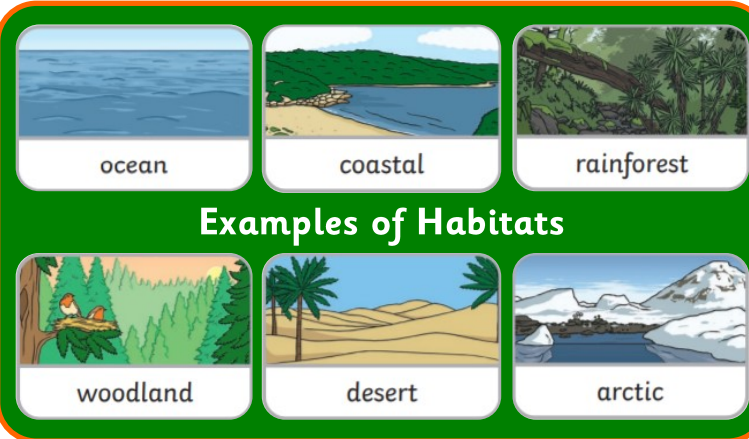
Food chain—Shows how each animal gets its food. One of the ways that living things depend on each other.
